

I caution you, this is a little bit longer than I intended, but it is important to read.

Since the beginning of 118th Congress in January of 2023, when the Republican Party gained the majority in the House of Representatives, not one piece of meaningful Legislation has been passed. In the first two years of the Biden Administration, when the Democratic Party held a slim majority in the House of Representatives and the Senate, some very significant Bills were passed:

1. The American Rescue Plan Act and extending existing Covid-19 programs, which stabilized the economy, preventing a recession, and helped the US to have the fastest post COVID recovery in the world. (did not have any Republican votes)
2. Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act, which began rebuilding long neglected infrastructure, such as roads and bridges, and created jobs, giving the US the lowest unemployment rate in decades.
3. Two Bills to avoid a government shutdown and keep the federal government running, as well as provided funding for disaster relief helping Afghanistan evacuees, and other appropriations.
4. Created a new National Holiday, Juneteenth National Independence Day Act, commemorating the end of slavery in the US.
5. The Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act, which banned imports from China's Xinjiang region, unless the importer could document that the manufacture was not a result of forced labor
6. The Consolidated Appropriations Act 2022, which funded; AGRICULTURE, RURAL DEVELOPMENT, SCIENCE, AND RELATED AGENCIES, DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE, ENERGY AND WATER DEVELOPMENT, DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR, ENVIRONMENT, DEPARTMENTS OF LABOR, HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, MILITARY CONSTRUCTION, VETERANS AFFAIRS, COVID SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS, UKRAINE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS, as well as; HEALTH PROVISIONS, CONSUMER PROTECTION, VETERANS MATTERS, VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN ACT REAUTHORIZATION, INTELLIGENCE AUTHORIZATION, along with dozens of other agencies and events. (31 of 49 Republican Senators voted against it, and 180 of 211 Republican Representatives opposed passage)
7. the landmark Inflation Reduction Act, making unprecedented investments in clean energy, finally allowing Medicare to negotiate drug prices, setting a \$2,000 cap on out-of-pocket pharmacy costs, capping insulin in Medicare at \$35 per prescription per month, and requiring rebates when drug prices increase faster than inflation.

The vast majority of Republicans have done nothing positive to benefit the American people since gaining control. This is the reason that in the past year, when previous supplements expired, childhood poverty has increased from 5.2% in 2021, more than doubling, to 12.4%, after 25 years of gradual decline. This is the reason many people are losing medical insurance coverage that Democrats have been fighting so hard to make available. This is the reason inflation is being fueled (pun intended) by the increasing rise in petroleum costs (despite record availability and the US producing more than any other nation). When fuel cost go up, the result is rising cost of everything

else. The Biden Administration has done much to curb inflation that resulted from COVID shortages, but Republican resistance in controlling record profits of the petroleum industry has allowed them to continue to gouge the American people.

This is one reason why it is important in the 2024 Election to maintain a Democratic President, and return Democratic control to both houses of Congress. It is the Democratic Legislators who support and work for the American people instead of the elites.
