Stop by the Campaign office for a lot of good information on candidates, yard signs for most candidates (we have a beautiful one for Harris/Walz! Thank you, Matt Runnels). I bought 2 extras for resale, which are \$20 - same price at the campaign office.

You can also sign up to help out in the office, phonebank, canvass, etc. Anne Lowe printed out a good "Map your contacts" worksheet from redwine.blue to help decide on at least 20 people in your own circle of influence to talk to.
