I would like to invite my fellow Democrats who have some time to spare to join me on Saturday, October 17th, at 9:00 a.m. at the park next to the Bayard Community Center. From there, we plan to find places on Tom Foy Boulevard to stand with signs reminding citizens about Early Voting and the Democratic candidates. If you have campaign signs, please bring them and if you make your own, I would only ask that they be in good taste. Also, please wear a mask and bring a chair if you are not able to stand for long periods of time. We will be standing or sitting 6 feet apart, wherever we are.

I am asking for volunteers to do this the whole two weeks of early voting. Early voting in Bayard is from Tuesday through Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. We want to do the same on Highway 180, in front of the county building from October 19th to October 30th and then again on Election Day. Voting in Silver City is open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

I would also ask our candidates who have extra signs for us to hold up to please let me know and I will pick them up. (Send me a text at 575-590-3016.)

If you would like to commit to doing this on any of the days please send me a text letting me know the date/dates and time/times and if you have your own sign that you will be displaying. I would like to have some kind of a schedule so that we know that all times are covered. Rick Lass has agreed to help line up some volunteers, so if you have already been approached by him it is not necessary to notify me.

Surprisingly, many people are not aware that early voting will be taking place, so I believe it is worth our time to be out there to remind them.
